National NFP Awareness Week

July 23-29, 2017

Natural Family Planning (NFP) methods represent authentic family planning. NFP can be used to both achieve and to postpone a pregnancy and makes use of periodic abstinence from marital relations based upon the observation of the woman's natural signs of fertility, in order to space births or to limit the number of children when there is a reason to do so. This practice fosters in couples an attitude of respect and wonder in the face of human life, which is sacred. It also fosters profound respect for one's spouse, which is necessary for authentic intimacy.
